- Describe a character and setting.

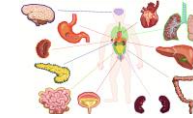


Science

The Human Body

Key areas of learning

- Identify and recognise **body parts in a human body**.
- **Name** and **identify** the **five senses**.
- Understand that we use our **eyes** to see.
- Know that **sound** travels through our **ears** to send messages to our brain.
- Know that our **senses** help to **understand** the **world** around us.
- Understand that some people have **problems** with their **senses**, such as **blindness** or **deafness**.



Maths

Place Value up to 10

Sort objects, count objects, count objects from a larger group, represent objects, recognise numbers as words, counting on from any number, 1 more and less, count back in 10s, compare groups and numbers, ordering objects and numbers, more than, less than and greater and equal to, fewer, more and same.

Addition, Subtraction up to 10, Geometry - Shapes

Number bonds to 10, add and subtract 1 and 2, subtraction, solve addition problems, Recognise and name common 2D and 3D shapes.



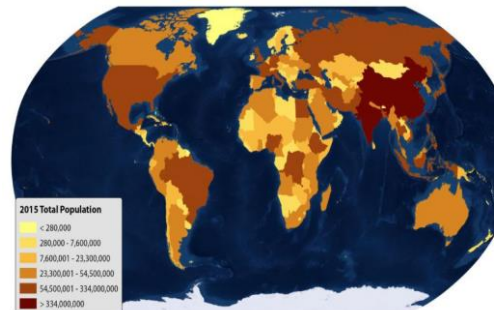
