Today in Music Year 4 learnt how to play the recorder and began practicing playing hot cross buns.


"We learnt how to play B A G on the recorder. I had to really concentrate when I was playing mine." Grigoris

Today the children learned a new song called Jumbo. The children also learned the song Jesu Ukukhanya and sang some more call and response lyrics.




"We sang the introduction and had to stand up and sing hello to everyone and they sang hello back." Kaleb

Ethan, Alex and Natari did a great job with their story writing. They worked hard to retell the story of Little Red Riding Hood.






