

## Religious Education Lent to Easter



### Key areas of learning

- The children will be learning about the events of Holy Week: Holy Thursday, Good Friday and Easter Sunday. These are known as the Triduum. The children will recap their knowledge of Palm Sunday.
- They will learn about the season of Lent and the importance of fasting, almsgiving and praying.
- They will focus on the death of Jesus and his resurrection, thinking about how Catholic beliefs derive from these events.
