for everything.

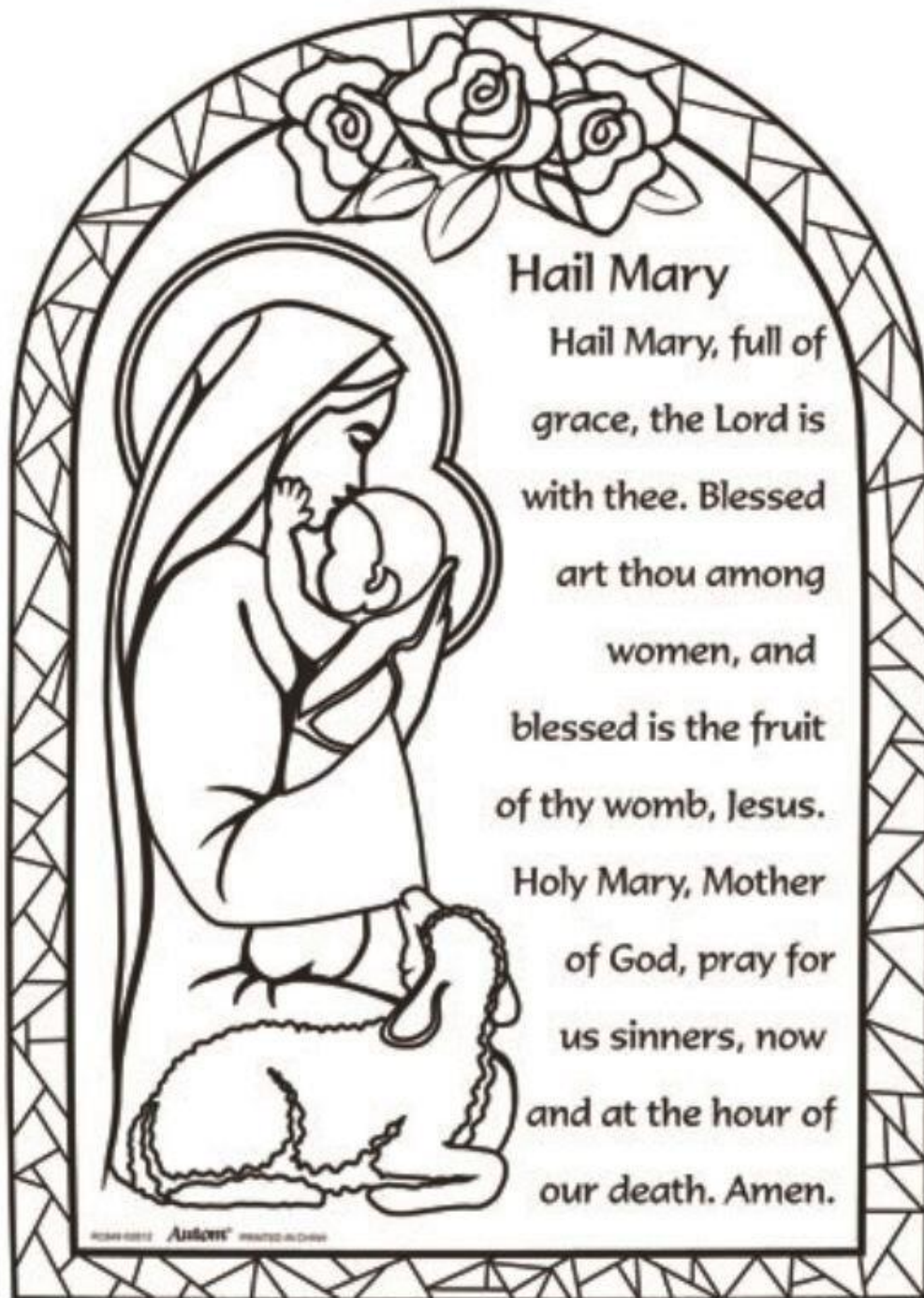

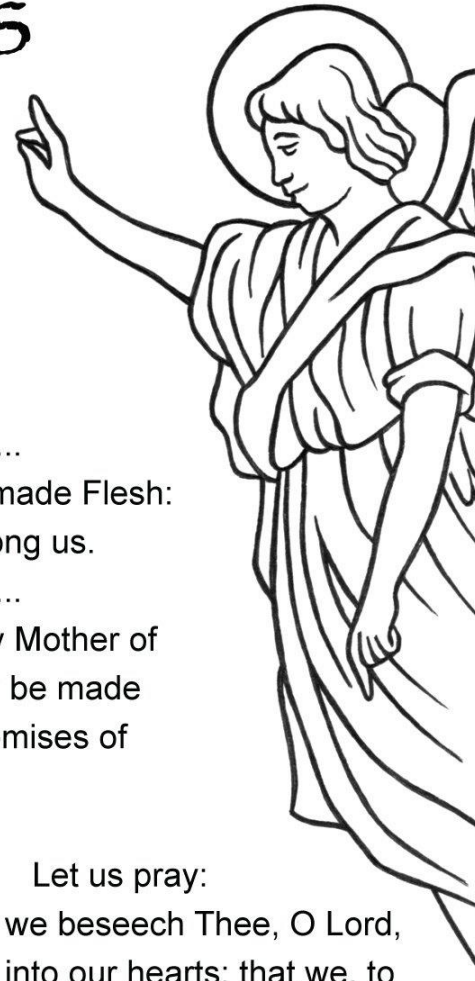
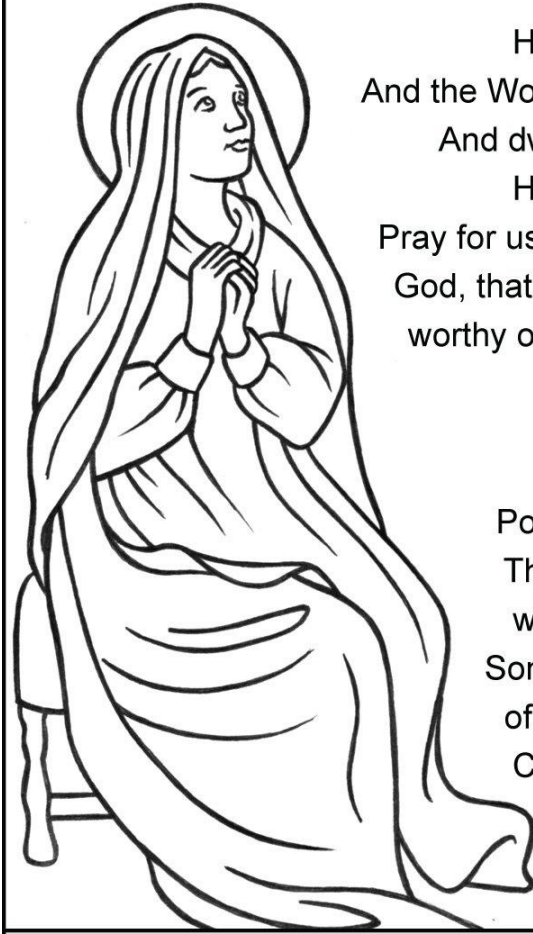

same Christ Our Lord. Amen.

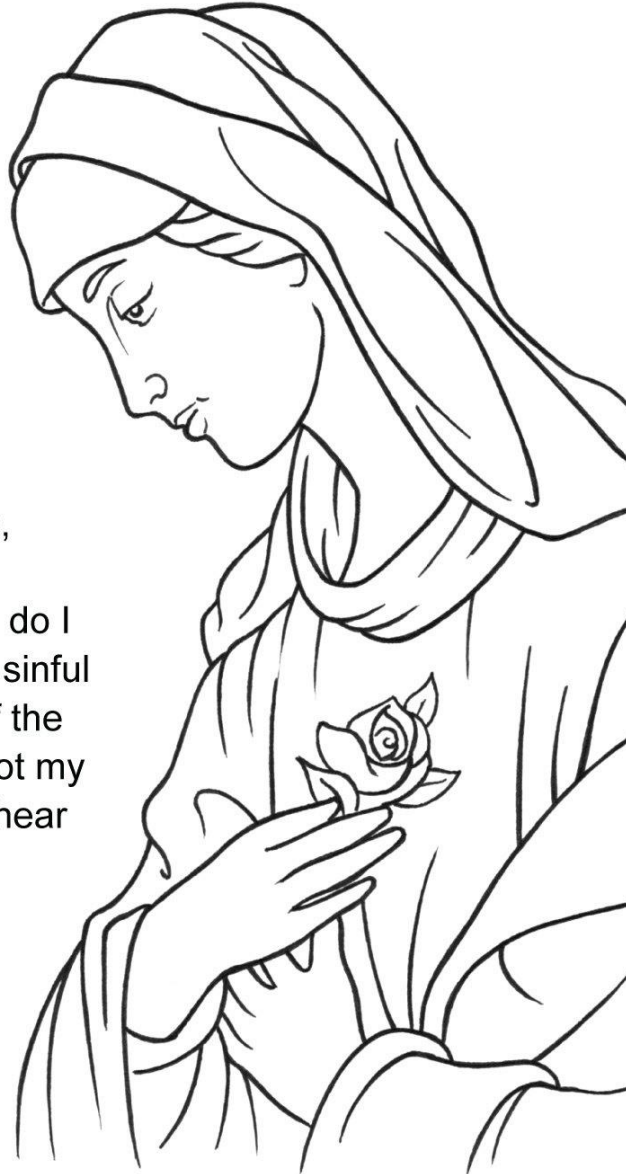


The Memorare
