<input type="checkbox"/> Lesson 1	<p>To know that the British Isles are a group of islands that include Britain and Ireland.</p> <p>Success criteria:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • I know that an island is a body of land entirely surrounded by water • I understand that we look at a map, the British Isles are made up of lots of islands, the main ones are Britain and Ireland • I know that there are 6,000 other small islands in the British Isles.
<input type="checkbox"/> Lesson 2	<p>To recognise Scotland as a country of the British Isles.</p> <p>Success criteria:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • I understand that Scotland is a country in the British Isles. • I understand that Scotland is located to the north of England. • I understand that the mainland of Scotland is part of the island of Britain.

Summer 1: Mediterranean Europe	
<input type="checkbox"/> Lesson 1	<p>To know that Mediterranean Europe is located in the southern part of Europe.</p> <p>Success criteria:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • I know that the Mediterranean Europe is the southern part of Europe. • I know that the Mediterranean Sea is almost completely surrounded by land. • 'I know that Mediterranean' comes from the Latin words meaning the middle of the land.
<input type="checkbox"/> Lesson 2	<p>To understand that the Mediterranean climate is warm and dry in the summer, cool and wet in the winter.</p> <p>Success criteria:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • I understand that I can find out information about climate from graphs that show temperature and rainfall. • I understand that the latitude of Mediterranean Europe is one reason why the climate is warm and dry. • I understand that the Gulf Stream keeps the temperature of Mediterranean Europe warm in the summer and mild in the winter.
