## **Prayer before Lunch**


Bless us O God as we sit together,

The world was in darkness and nobody knew the way to the Father as you and I do. They needed a light to show them the way, and the great light shone on Christmas Day.



# Guardian Angel Prayer


Angel of God,




### **Act of Contrition**
