Key areas of learning

- The children will be learning about the story of Pentecost.
- The children will be encouraged to use specialist vocabulary to make links between each of the miraculous signs in John's Gospel and Christian beliefs about Jesus, including the sacraments.
- They will have the opportunity to read about the outpouring of the Holy Spirit on the Messiah in the Old Testament and the Gospels, making links to the Sacrament of Confirmation.
- They will be learning about Catholic Social Teaching and will describe some ways Christians work together to promote common good.

- To plan the features of a web page.
- To consider the ownership and use of images (copyright).
- To recognise the need to preview pages.
- To outline the need for a navigation path.
- To recognise the implications of linking to content owned by other people.

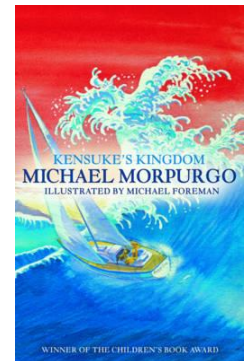
