SCIENCE WEEK

This year, British Science Week marks its 30th Anniversary. For this milestone, they are partnering with the Royal Observatory Greenwich to bring this year's theme to life. The theme is 'time'. The children completed an investigation relating to this during the week. They also dressed up as scientists during the week!



YEAR 4 SCIENCE VISIT

The children were invited to All Saints College to do some science based work. The children were super excited to travel by mini bus. On arrival they were taken to the science lab where Mr Williams spoke to the children about living organisms and gave them a task of labelling the parts of a microscope. After this they all took a piece of onion each, some iodine and a microscope to look closer at the cells inside an onion. Some children said the cells were very small and others described them as the size of a football.

Honey: "I enjoyed when we looked through the microscopes and when we were answering the questions about the living organisms."

Auriel: "I liked the ride on the mini bus and I also enjoyed looking through the microscopes and labelling the different parts."
