Lesson 1	<b>Printmaking:</b> Look at pattern and texture in the environment and think about how we can capture this in a visual way. <b>Theme:</b> An introduction to printmaking. Lesson 2	<b>Printmaking:</b> To make repeated and rotated prints using found objects. <b>Theme:</b> Exploring printing with found objects.	Lesson 2	<b>Sculpture:</b> To explore a range of joining techniques for your own sculpture project. <b>Theme:</b> Exploring joining techniques for sculpture.
Lesson 3	<b>Printmaking:</b> To explore repeated patterns, and overlap colours and shapes on our prints. <b>Theme:</b> Making our own stamps for printmaking.	Lesson 3	<b>Sculpture:</b> To begin to create our own piece of sculpture. <b>Theme:</b> Designing and making our own sculpture.
Lesson 4	<b>Printmaking:</b> To draw and design for a collagraph, creating a textured printing surface. <b>Theme:</b> Making a collagraph print.	Lesson 4	<b>Sculpture:</b> Consider ways to add colour and pattern to the surfaces of our sculpture. <b>Theme:</b> Adapting and reviewing our sculpture work
Lesson 5	<b>Printmaking:</b> To review your printmaking processes so far, make collages from your prints and review your work. <b>Theme:</b> Reviewing and presenting our printmaking work.	Lesson 5	<b>Sculpture:</b> To identify different ways to present our sculpture <b>Theme:</b> Presenting our sculpture work.
