Reception Open Morning


We welcomed prospective parents on Tuesday for our Open morning. They enjoyed seeing the school in action!

Science in Y6

Year 6 have been learning about Light and this week they learnt and observed how light is reflected. We used a torch, a mirror and a piece of card with a small slit to see if the light reflects in the mirror. From this we observed two rays of light: the incidence ray and the reflected ray. Children learnt that the incidence ray always equals the angle of reflection and that all objects reflect light.

The School Council led an assembly to encourage all to spread kindness through our words. Each child will be decorating a fabric bunting with their chosen kind word. 

The children in art club created fabulous poppies this week!





Year 2 writing about Remembrance Day!




Nia in Y6 wrote a Remembrance Day Acrostic poem!


