Vocabulary

Blessing: God's favour and protection.

Doxology: A form of praise to God.

Epiphany: A 'manifestation' or 'display' of a moment when we have a strong awareness of the God's presence among us.

Gospel: The teaching of Christ's life in four books. It is the Good News about Jesus.

Intercession: A prayer to God on someone else's behalf.

Petition: A request that is made for something desired.

Prayer: A spiritual communion with God involving thanksgiving, adoration, a request for help or confession.

Sermon: A talk or teaching on a religious or moral subject.
