## Vocabulary

**Blessing:** God's favour and protection.

**Doxology:** A form of praise to God.

**Epiphany:** A 'manifestation' or 'display' of a moment when we have a strong awareness of the God's presence among us.

**Gospel:** The teaching of Christ's life in four books. It is the Good News about Jesus.

**Intercession:** A prayer to God on someone else's behalf.

**Petition:** A request that is made for something desired.

**Prayer:** A spiritual communion with God involving thanksgiving, adoration, a request for help or confession.

**Sermon:** A talk or teaching on a religious or moral subject.
