What should I already know?

- A disciple is a follower of Jesus.
- There were 12 disciples.
- A Pentecost person is someone who lives their faith and their actions are based on what they believe in.
- St Peter was a Pentecost person.
- Jesus called St Peter and his brother Andrew to be followers of Jesus and to be fisher of men.

What am I going to learn?

- Jesus asks people to leave what they are doing and to go with him.
- People gathered around Jesus to learn from him and to take up the way of life he talked about and lived.
- A disciple is a learner of Jesus' teachings.
- Peter, James and John are joined by a group of 9 to become what Mark calls 'The 12.'
- Jesus called his first disciples; Simon, Andrew, John and James.
- These disciples were fishermen who were simple, ordinary, everyday people – who chose to leave everything behind to follow Jesus.
- To follow Jesus means to follow his way of life.

Vocabulary

Prayer: Prayer is talking to God. It's telling Him what's going on, asking for help, thanking and praising him and seeking forgiveness.

Mark – Mark is one of the four Gospel Writers.

Disciples- The disciples were the students of Jesus. There were 12 disciples who followed and learnt from Jesus.

Rabbi: A Jewish teacher of the Jewish community.

Lake Galilee: This is a fresh water lake in Israel. This is where Jesus called some of his Disciples.

Persecution: When a person is killed because of their belief.

Fisher of men: Calling people to be followers of Jesus.
