What should I already know?

Vocabulary

Apostles: The Apostles were special followers of Jesus.

Easter: It is the Christian celebration of the resurrection of Jesus Christ.

Pentecost: It is celebrated on the Sunday 50 days after Easter. Christians celebrate the gift of the Holy Spirit.

Prayer: Prayer is talking to God. It is telling Him what's going on, asking for help, thanking and praising him and seeking forgiveness.

Resurrection: Resurrection is when someone is brought back to life after they have died.

Scripture: The writing in the Bible is scripture.
