Shared Reading

Reading our Spring 1 text 'Street child' we will **listen, read, explore, predict, infer, retrieve** and **summarise** the **text** whilst using high quality **vocabulary**.

- To be able to predict and imagine what might happen next in a considered piece of writing
- To be able to retrieve and infer using both teacher modelling but also guided questions
- To be able to summarise what's happened in the text and show good understanding on an individual basis.
- To develop their word knowledge and understanding meaning in different contexts.

Science

Living Things

Key areas of learning learnt in Year 5 are:

- To recognise how plants and animals in our local area change throughout the year.
- To know that Mammals and Amphibians have different life cycles.
- To know that insects and Birds have different life cycles.
- To know that flowering plants need pollen to reproduce.
- To know that Jane Goodall and David Attenborough have dedicated their lives to studying the natural world and communicating their findings.

Maths

Children in Year 5 will be developing their knowledge of Multiplication, division and fractions in Spring 1. The knowledge learnt in Autumn 1 and 2 will assist them gaining greater depth.

Multiplication and Division B

Multiply up to 4 digit by 1 digit, Multiply 4,3,2 digit numbers by 2 digit numbers, short division, divide 4 digit numbers by 1 digit numbers, divide with remainders.

Fractions B

Multiply unit and non unit fractions by an integer, fractions of amounts and quantities, finding the whole and use fractions as operators.
