
Key areas of learning:

Art: Design

Key areas of learning:

Design	how the different elements of artwork blend together to make a piece of art
Composition	another word for design in art
Collage	a picture that is created by sticking pieces of paper, or other materials, to a background
Expressionism	a type of art where the elements of art (colour, light, line, shape, form, space and texture) create a work of art which shows strong emotions
Complementary colours	any two colours which are opposite each other on the colour wheel are complementary to each other
