



Islam Progression

Year Group	Topic/Content
Nursery	➤ Lesson 1: Belonging – Introduce that Muslims belong to a faith community. Share a simple story of a Muslim family praying together. ➤ Lesson 2: Special Places – Look at pictures of a mosque. Children learn it is a place where Muslims pray and worship.
Reception	➤ Lesson 1: Special People – Learn that Muhammad is the Prophet of Islam. Share simple stories about his kindness and honesty. ➤ Lesson 2: Caring for Others – Introduce the importance of kindness, generosity and helping others in Islam
Year 1	➤ Lesson 1: Sacred Texts – Learn that the Qur'an is the holy book of Islam and is treated with great respect. ➤ Lesson 2: Symbols and Belonging – Explore the crescent moon and star and discuss why Muslims may use symbols to represent their faith.
Year 2	➤ Lesson 1: The Mosque – Explore features of a mosque including the prayer hall, prayer mats, minaret and mihrab. ➤ Lesson 2: Community – Learn about prayer, worship and how Muslims support each other within their community.
Year 3	➤ Lesson 1: Festivals – Learn about Eid al-Fitr and how Muslims celebrate the end of Ramadan. ➤ Lesson 2: Ramadan – Explore why Muslims fast during Ramadan and what they learn from this experience.
Year 4	➤ Lesson 1: The Five Pillars – Learn about the Five Pillars of Islam and why they are important for Muslims. ➤ Lesson 2: Prayer – Explore the importance of Salah and why Muslims pray five times each day.
Year 5	➤ Lesson 1: The Hajj – Learn about the pilgrimage to Mecca and why it is important for Muslims. ➤ Lesson 2: Commitment – Discuss what it means to live as a Muslim today and how beliefs influence everyday life.
Year 6	➤ Lesson 1: Faith in Action – Explore how Muslims put beliefs into practice through charity (Zakah), compassion and serving their communities. ➤ Lesson 2: Respect and Diversity – Reflect on how learning about Islam helps us understand and respect people of different faiths and beliefs.
